LEADERSHIP EDUCATIONAL SESSION Comm. McLaughlin called the February 5, 2021 Education Meeting of the Board of Commissioners of King County Public Hospital District No. 2 to order at 7:03 a.m. and welcomed those present.

## PRESENTATIONS and DISCUSSION

**Welcome** Jeff Tomlin, MD, CEO welcomed everyone to the meeting and

reviewed the agenda for risk-based payor contracting.

Gregg Aoyama, Director of Payer, Employer & D2B Initiatives and Monique Gablehouse, COO, Post-Acute Care, presented the EvergreenHealth Partners (EHP) Final Assessment which included a review of EHP history, definitions of value based contracting payment types, payor contract summary, key observations and conclusions, etc. The team responded to questions from the Board throughout.

**Eastside Health Network Update** 

David LaMarche, COA, Eastside Health Network (EHN), thanked, Tina Mycroft, CFO, Ms. Gablehouse and Mr. Aoyama for their leadership throughout the EHN journey and welcomed Rachel Lam, EHN Financial Analyst. Mr. LaMarche, presented the EHN update which included a review of EHN's approach to population health, value based landscape, the shift to value based care, and flow of funds methodology. Additionally, the team reviewed performance highlights and lessons learned from 2017-2020, and

gave a preview of 2021. The team responded to questions from the Board throughout.

EvergreenHealth Update on Risk-Based Contracts Including BPCI-A Mr. Aoyama presented the EvergreenHealth update on additional risk-based contracts which included a review of CMS Bundled Payment for Care Improvement Advanced (BPCI-A). The review included patient volume and reconciliation reports for model years 1-3, and changes for model year 4 noting the biggest change is they are moving from participation in individual episodes to participation by service lines containing multiple episodes. We have had strong success in our reconciliation, anticipate more savings in the end of 2020 and overall we believe we can continue saving as we move into the new service line model. Mr. Aoyama noted it is likely that this program will be mandatory over time. We have learned a lot in the initial years of this and are fortunate to have had that opportunity.

Mr. Aoyama also reviewed the value-based care quality parameters and further movement from fee for service (FFS) to value-based contracting. He responded to questions from the Board throughout.

**CEO Update** 

Dr. Tomlin provided a brief update on strategic planning efforts and the COVID vaccine. He responded to questions from the Board throughout.
