Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of King County Public Hospital District No. 2 will hold a Public Hearing on the Proposed 2021 Budget at 7:00 a.m. on Friday, November 13, 2020. Immediately after the Hearing, the Board will hold a Special Board Meeting to consider approval of the Proposed 2021 Budget.

If Governor Inslee's Proclamation 20-28.11 is not extended past November 9, 2020, the meeting will take place in room Tan-100/101 in the Evergreen Surgery and Physicians Center, located adjacent to Evergreen Hospital Medical Center, 12040 NE 128th Street, Kirkland. Free parking is available in the hospital parking garage. Due to COVID-19 space limitations, space for public attendance will be available in Tan-142 with a web/audio connection to the live meeting. If Governor Inslee's Proclamation 20-28.11 is extended past November 9, 2020, the meeting will be held solely via phone using the below information allowing remote attendance for all participants and members of the public.
